



## CAMP OKAWEHNA – WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

### Campers Personal List (Please remember to label campers items)

#### Sleeping, Bedding Etc.

- Sleeping Bag or 2 Twin Size Sheets-**Mandatory**
- Pillow- Please bring your own
- Blanket-**Mandatory**

#### Clothing- Bring Enough Clothing for 7 days

- Summer clothing (Shorts or pants, t-shirts and comfortable clothing)
- Tennis shoes and Two pair of comfortable shoes
- Sweater/Jacket-**Mandatory**
- Hat or sun visor-**Mandatory**
- Dress Up clothing for Dances
- Long Pants and Long Shirts/Sweatshirts (sometimes it gets cold at night)
- Rain poncho or an umbrella
- Bathing suit
- Pajamas

#### Bathroom Items and Toiletries

- Beach/ Shower Towels-**Mandatory**
- Wash Cloths
- Soap
- Deodorant
- Shampoo
- Toothbrush and Toothpaste
- Comb/Brush
- Shower Shoes/ Flip Flops

#### Camping Items

- Flashlight and batteries
- Suntan Lotion
- Baseball/Softball glove-*Optional*
- Fishing Pole-*Optional*

#### Medication

- **On the Medication Form provided, include a list of medications with dosage and actual time taken. Please include enough medicine for 7 days that is labeled with campers name in a pill box. Please include all medicine, even if it is only taken when needed.**
